Chairman David Schultz called the meeting to order at 6:34 p.m. in the Baroda Township Municipal Building Meeting Room. There were no audience members.

The minutes of the last Planning Commission meeting were distributed. Tom Lippert moved, seconded by David Schultz to approve the February 22, 2011 minutes. Vote – All Yes Motion Carried.

There was no Building Inspector's report. Wendie Shafer reported that a zoning permit application had been received for a pole barn on Miller Road from Rich Weich.

Ed Heyn asked what is happening with the Ronald Ellsworth situation. Wendie reported that Kim Fowler has been working with Mr. Ellsworth and that progress is being made.

Discussion was held about police coverage in Baroda since the Police Department had moved to Lake Township. The commissioners requested a report of hours and calls made to Baroda in the last month. Wendie is to get report from Police Dept. or from Police Board minutes.

Wendie Shafer gave a report on a seminar on the Medical Marijuana Law and answered questions. There was much discussion about the limitations on what the Planning Commission, and Township officials can do to monitor or regulate this activity within the Township.

Wendie Shafer reported that the Lakeshore School Superintendent plans to speak at the March 21, 2011 Township Board meeting. Several Commissioners expressed an interest in attending the meeting. (Date is in error. Superintendent Vujea is scheduled speak on April 18, 2011)
